To Share The Beauty




These magnificent horses reside at the United Pegasus Foundation, a horse rescue and sanctuary in California.

Horses speak to directly to our hearts. Throughout history, they have served humankind with strength and grace, whether in the military, on farms, in sports, as loving companions or as therapy animals. They are a unique symbol of service and freedom, of beauty and balance. They are art in motion.

Horses have a fascinating history, the earliest members of the horse family may have originated as long as 55 - 60 million years ago and the modern day Equus form 1-4 million years ago in the Americas. After Equus' range expanded into Asia, Europe and Africa they disappeared from the Americas an estimated 10,000 - 11,000 years ago. The Spanish later reintroduced them into North America in the 1500's. The beloved horse has a life expectancy of 25 to 30 years, but the oldest verifiable horse on record was a horse named "Old Billy" who lived in the 1800's. Old Billy lived to the age of 62!

This year I had the privilege of creating a photographic essay book about the United Pegasus Foundation, a horse rescue that I describe in my blog below. I rode horses when I was a child and it was wonderful to reconnect with these stunning animals. I could have spent endless hours watching and photographing them as they ate, rested, galloped, and interacted with each other in their distinct and special way.
